3. A sealed high school transcript must be attached to this form, and you must have at least a **3.5** grade point average to apply.
4. Please attach **three (3)** letters of reference, none of which should be from a family member.
5. You must provide documentation of at least **150** hours of community service and/or volunteer hours accumulated in grades 9-12 and any work experience that can be documented by an employer.
6. The recipient of the scholarship will be notified by the end of April.
7. Distribution of the scholarship funds will be sent by certified mail to the student when the Scholarship Committee receives documentation confirming proof of enrollment from the student.
